

## Packing List For 1941-1945 (For the Asia Pacific War)

### Rifleman Basic Combat Set

- ❑ **Type 98 tunic set:**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original or Sakurai.
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Nakata or S&Graf
- ❑ **Collar rank tabs:** *Early "Pillow" tabs for T98 collars*
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Furuta, Sakurai
- ❑ **Jyuban(Bosho-i):** *White and two tone: early war-entire war, dark: post-1943*
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Nakajima
- ❑ **Jyuban(Round necked)(Optional):** *Used throughout the 30's and WW2, extremely versatile*
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Nakajima
- ❑ **Collar liner:** *DIY or Furuta*
- ❑ **Field Cap:** *Showa 14 Field Cap or Showa 18(For Post 1943 events).*
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Furuta or Original.
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Sakurai
  - ❑ *Unacceptable:* Any other repro
- ❑ **Field cap havelocks(Optional)**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original or Furuta
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Nakata or Sakurai
  - ❑ *Unacceptable:* Hikishop or any other repro
- ❑ **Boots:** *Showa 5 boots and Jikatabi. Must get Furuta or OG boot laces for Faisal repros*
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Furuta, or Faisal repro, Rikio or Maguro rubber topped Jikatabi
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Giretsu Showa 5 boots
- ❑ **Belt Set:** *Early and Late Ko Pouch Sets. Early Ko(T38) Pouches Preferred*
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Cocomomo(Treated), Hikishop(Treated),
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Nakata(Treated)
  - ❑ *Unacceptable:* IMA USA, Taobao, zpjpw, Atlanta cutlery, Worldwarsupply
- ❑ **Puttees:** *Early war color preferred*
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original or Sakurai repro
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Mid war puttees
- ❑ **Haversack:** *Showa 14 most common, Showa 12 and Showa 7 not uncommon*
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Nakata, or Sakurai
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Hikishop, S&Graf
- ❑ **Canteen:** *S5 Canteen most common, Meiji Canteen and Taisho mod uncommon but used. Later war straps OK for late war*

- Preferred: Original*
- Acceptable: Nakata, Hikishop, S&Graf*
- Bayonet: *Original Bayonets only***
  - Preferred: Hooked quillion bayonets*
  - Acceptable: Midwar straight quillon(Post 1943)*
  - Unacceptable: Late War*
- Rifle:**
  - Preferred: Type 38 rifle*
  - Acceptable: Type 99 rifle (Especially for post-1943)*
- Helmet: *Hikishop or Nakata repainted with accurate paint job***
  - Helmet net(Optional) much preferred*
  - Contact us for help with getting helmet treated*
- Helmet Cover(Optional): *Early war has no band, later war has a band***
  - Preferred: Sakurai or Nakata*
  - Acceptable: Modified Hikishop*
- Gas Mask Bag(Optional):**
  - Preferred: Original, Nakata, Sakurai, or Hiki*
- Camouflage foliage net**
  - Hikishop or Original*
- Underwear: *Fundoshi or period boxers***
  - Preferred: Rokushaku fundoshi*
  - Acceptable: Etchyu fundoshi, Period boxers if wearer desires*
- White knit cotton gloves**
- Tenugui(Optional but recommended)**
- Dogtag: *OG or repro acceptable, must be tied around body with white flat cotton cord or string***

### Optional Uniform Items

- Bosho-i tunic set: *Showa 13 preferred, Showa 17 only acceptable for late war('44-'45)***
  - Preferred: Original*
  - Acceptable: Nakata*
- Sun helmet: *Type 98***
  - Preferred: Original or Furuta*

## **Basic Marching Set**

- Type 99 “Tako” Rucksack**
  - Preferred: Original*
  - Acceptable: Hikishop or Nakata*
- Mess kit “Hango”:** *Please include period utensils such as spoons, knives, and chopsticks*
  - Preferred: Original*
  - Acceptable: Modified post-war or Nakata*
- Shovel or Pickaxe:** *Early preferred, T98 acceptable*
- Shelter half**
  - S&Graf for unit compatibility*
  - Please use French or Danish army wooden tent stakes for unit compatibility*
  - Please use Swiss milsurp tent poles for unit compatibility*
- Contents:** *Extra uniforms, ration packs, personal items, change of clothes*
- Blanket(Optional):** *Original IJA blankets*
- Raincoat**
  - Preferred: Original or Sakurai*
  - Acceptable: Hikishop*
- Greatcoat:** *Type 98 Greatcoat*
  - Preferred: Original*
  - Acceptable: Hikishop*

For the most part uses same items from T98/MW2 list with some differences

- ❑ **Type 5 or Type 45 Kai tunic set:**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original or Sakurai.
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Nakata
  - ❑ *Unacceptable:* Hikishop, S&graf, taobao etc
- ❑ **Shoulder ranks:**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Furuta, Sakurai
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* S&Graf, Nakata
- ❑ **Jyuban(Round necked)**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Nakajima
- ❑ **Collar liner: DIY or Furuta**
- ❑ **Field Cap: Showa 11 or Ersatz, Showa 14 good for Khalkin Gol**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Furuta or Original.
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Sakurai
  - ❑ *Unacceptable:* Any other repro
- ❑ **Field cap havelocks(Seen in Khalkin Gol)**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original or Furuta
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Nakata or Sakurai
  - ❑ *Unacceptable:* Hikishop or any other repro
- ❑ **Boots: Showa 5 boots and Jikatabi. Must get Furuta or OG boot laces for Faisal repros**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Furuta, or Faisal repro, Rikio or Maguro rubber topped Jikatabi
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Giretsu Showa 5 boots
- ❑ **Belt Set: Early Ko Pouch Sets(T38)**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Hikishop(Treated), Nakata(Treated)
  - ❑ *Unacceptable:* IMA USA, Taobao, zpjpw, Atlanta cutlery, Worldwarsupply
- ❑ **Puttees: Early war color preferred**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original or Sakurai repro
  - ❑ *Acceptable:* Mid war puttees if early war not available
- ❑ **Haversack: Showa 12 or Showa 7, Taisho 3 also acceptable**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original, Nakata, or Sakurai
- ❑ **Canteen: S5 Canteen most common, Meiji Canteen and Taisho mod also common**
  - ❑ *Preferred:* Original

- Acceptable: Nakata, Hikishop, S&Graf*
- Bayonet:** *Original Bayonets only*
  - Preferred: Hooked quillion bayonets*
  - Unacceptable: Late War, Midwar straight quillon*
- Rifle:**
  - Preferred: Type 38 rifle*
